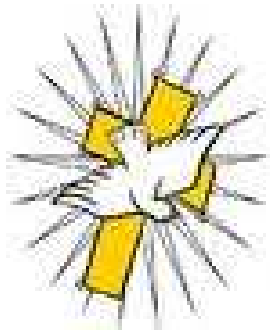

STALYBRIDGE SPLASH BANK HOLIDAY MONDAY MAY 31st

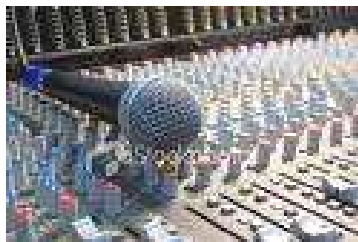
Have you signed up yet to help at this event?

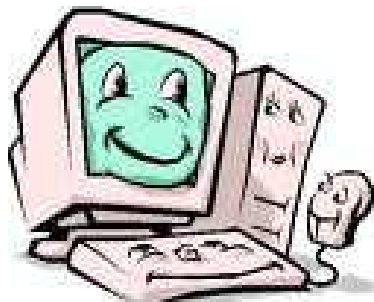


CALLING ALL TECHIES!

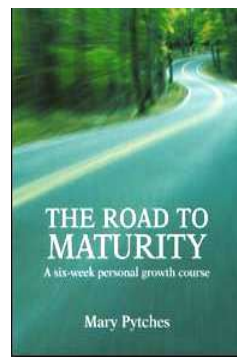
LAST CALL
